



Rev. Dr. Teddy Sakupapa

Rev. Dr. Teddy Sakupapa is an ordained minister in the Presbyterian tradition and current Deputy Moderator of World Council of Churches' Commission on Education and Ecumenical Formation. A member of the Uniting Presbyterian Church in Southern Africa, Rev. Dr. Sakupapa is senior lecturer in the Department of Religion and Theology at the University of the Western Cape in South Africa where he teaches ecumenical studies and social ethics.

His research traverses the fields of ecumenical studies, systematic theology and social ethics, decoloniality, African theology, and the history of Christianity in Africa on which he has published several articles and book chapters. He completed his doctoral thesis on the inter-relatedness between "Ecclesiology and Ethics" in ecumenical debates of the late twentieth – early twenty-first century. Rev. Dr. Sakupapa previously taught systematic theology at then United Church of Zambia theological college (now UCZ University) where he also held additional responsibilities for ministerial formation of UCZ candidate for the ordained ministry.
